The plan includes a Vision for our community and 13 Pathways to the Future — areas of action that will move us to a more sustainable future. It's about looking at the whole, thinking long term and seeing the connections.

About the Champions Agreements

What are the benefits of becoming a Cochrane Sustainability Champion?

What are Cochrane Sustainability Champion Agreements?

Champion Agreements have been created to give businesses, institutions and organizations a chance to show their desire to do their part towards the Cochrane Sustainability Plan Vision and Pathways. By becoming a Champion, businesses and organizations are saying that they will contribute to a more sustainable future for Cochrane, both in their own work and through collaboration with other Champions and the broader community.

What is my commitment as a Champion?

As a Cochrane Sustainability Champion, your business / organization / institution agrees that the Vision and Pathways to the Future in the Cochrane Sustainability Plan are an important direction for the future of our community. As a Cochrane Sustainability Champion, you commit to (and can expect fellow Champions to commit to):

Share Complete an Action Worksheet identifying your activities and progress by

the end of the year. From time to time, you can contribute your stories to

and tools. Do you have a great idea that others can benefit from? These workshops will be an opportunity to share these ideas and lessons learned.

In addition, you can benefit from the ideas and experiences of other

farther the community will move on implementing the plan.

By signing on as a Champion, are we expected to act on all of the Pathways all the time?

No. Champions are asked to declare which of the 13 Pathways they can have an impact on within their existing mandate. Depending on the focus of the business, organization or institution, this could be just one Pathway, all 13, or somewhere in between.

Who can become a Champion?

Any interested organization, business, institution or community group that is committed to the Vision and Pathways to the Future within the Cochrane Sustainability Plan can become a Champion.

How do I become a Cochrane Sustainability Champion?

You can become a Champion in three simple steps:

- Review the Cochrane Sustainability Plan, particularly the Vision and Pathways to the Future on pages 17-46.
- 2. Complete the Champion Agreement by identifying which Pathways you can make a difference on and signing the document.
